



# Horse Show Information

## TRAILERING FEES:

Quoted based on the number of horses going, We either ship in a air-ride semi or 6 horse head to head. We will collect checks with the check for the horse show.

## TRAINER EXPENSES:

Will be split evenly amongst all the riders and invoiced following the show. (Lodging, food, and travel expenses).

## GROOMING/SET UP FEES:

If you are not able to be at the show to set up or break down, load or unload your horse. You will be billed \$25 additional per day. If you have a full groom, you will not be required to do this. If you have another rider help with your horse because, you can not be there. This person must help load and unload equipment, tack trunks, hay, and help break down/set up.

Full grooming is available for \$50/day, Partial Groom \$35/Day (First time horse showers, this is a good option)

Braiding is optional at a lot of horse shows we will be traveling to. We will give an update, weeks prior to be prepared for that cost. Anything most school horses will show in, will not require braiding.

## ENTRIES AND CANCELLATIONS:

Checks for the horse show stalls are due to Tammy or Aimee, 1 month prior to the show. Checks Must be made out to Show Facility. Please put the riders name in the memo.

You will still be responsible for stabling fees and split on the tack stall if you cancel beyond this date.

If a horse goes lame and we are able to use the stall, is the only exception to this rule.

## SCHOOL HORSE SHOW LEASE:

\$250-550/show depending on the horse. Payment for show lease is due on the first of the month. You will be able to lesson on the show horse at least one time before the horse show. There will be no room for extra lessons on show lease school horses.

Horse Options for shows (as of right now): Rogan, Logan, Benny, Derby, Dexter, Irish, Dreamer. This is Subject to change based on if school horses before unavailable due to being fully leased out.

This Includes use of tack, wraps, blankets, and grooming supplies. (Please pack your own fly spray and shampoo)

## HOTEL & CAMPING:

Aimee will typically book hotel blocks for horse shows with a large number of people. Recently, we have been renting Air BnB's and have enjoyed that over staying in a hotel or camping. You are not obligated to stay in the selected hotel or house. It is just to provide everyone with a better rate.

If you plan to camp at any of the horse shows, you must make advanced reservations. We do not handle that. Most venues have camper hook ups.

## TRAINER FEES:

\$50/DAY RING SIDE/SCHOOLING COACHING PER RIDER

\$35/DAY FOR TRAINERS TO SHOW OR PRO RIDE HORSE IN ADDITION TO  
SCHOOLING ON THE GROUND.
